*NOTE: SOPHOMORES: If you are taking Comp B and Advanced Comp B your JUNIOR year in preparation for PNW's CEP English 104/231 your SENIOR year, you will need a 3 OR 4-inch binder (4-inch preferred). Buy this from Office Depot as the Dollar Store binders will spontaneously combust after one month of wear. Spend the extra few bucks and buy a GOOD QUALITY binder as you will keep this as your portfolio for the next two and one-half years with me. The journal should go in the binder; the binder will be kept in my room from year-to-year. When you leave me your senior year, you will have a collection of all your work to show the institution you decide to attend.

BINDER—DO NOT BUY FROM THE DOLLAR STORE. THEY WILL NOT LAST. OFFICE DEPOT HAS HEAVY-DUTY, QUALITY BINDERS. SPEND THE EXTRA MONEY NOW, ESPECIALLY STUDENTS WHO WILL HAVE ME FOR TWO OR TWO AND ONE-HALF YEARS.

IF YOU ALREADY HAD ME FOR COMP A, COMP B, AND/OR ADV. COMP B, YOU DO NOT NEED TO BUY SAID ITEMS (UNLESS THEY DID NOT SURVIVE). I STRONGLY ADVISED YOU TO KEEP THEM FOR THE NEXT CLASSES WITH ME. IF THEY SOMEHOW MADE THEIR WAY TO A BACKYARD BONFIRE AS KINDLING OR WERE TOSSED ON A FUNERAL PYRE, YOU NEED TO PURCHASE SAID ITEMS AGAIN AS BINDERS/PORTFOLIOS ARE GRADED AND WORTH QUITE A HEFTY GRADE.
